A one-day workshop on writing a project research report was conducted by Department of Zoology and Genetics for Final year Genetics students with guidelines for writing effective and well-structured research reports. The workshop aimed to improve academic writing, ensure proper documentation of research findings, and enhance presentation skills.

The workshop began with an insightful introduction to the fundamentals of research, emphasizing the importance of problem identification, defining objectives, and the role of ethical considerations in academic work. The participants were taught how to effectively write abstract, review literature, present their Results, using appropriate tables, figures, and statistical evidence, Discussion section to interpret the findings, compare them with existing literature, and explain their significance. The Conclusion and Recommendations segment wrapped up the research by summarizing the key findings, reflecting on limitations, and offering suggestions for future studies or practical applications.
